- .5 oz Amaro

Drizzle of dry red wine on top

Serve in a rocks glass over ice

- This featured cocktail receives its name from Clifford Griffin, owner of 7:30 Mine and beloved citizen of Silver Plume during the mining days. Every evening he played his violin, engaging town members through the incredible acoustics of the valley.
